

**TOWN OF KIRKWOOD
PUBLIC HEARING**

April 27, 2010

A public hearing regarding the adoption of a Local Law of the Town of Kirkwood for the year 2010 which would impose a 6 month moratorium on the issuance of floodplain development permits pursuant to Flood Damage Prevention Local Law No. 11 of the Year 2003 was held on April 27, 2010 at 6:07 PM at the Joseph A. Griffin Town Hall with Supervisor Gordon Kniffen presiding.

Supervisor Kniffen verified that he had affidavits of posting and publication in the Press & Sun Bulletin and The Country Courier and a short EAF had been filed.

Supervisor Kniffen explained that FEMA has released preliminary flood maps and they will not become official until each municipality adopts them, by April 2011. In the meantime the Board decided to consider a 6 month moratorium, with the consideration of a 6 month extension until the maps are adopted.

Supervisor Kniffen opened the hearing to public comment. Hearing none, Supervisor Kniffen closed the hearing at 6:08 PM.
