Supervisor Kniffen verified that he had affidavits of posting and publication in the Press & Sun Bulletin and The Country Courier and a short EAF had been filed.

Mr. Kline explained that when the Planning Board made their last revision there was a change made that if a person had a permit and a new building was constructed on neighboring, adjacent or property directly opposite within 100 feet of the outdoor furnace, the permit holder would have one year to increase the stack height. Language in the old law said or get a variance which was removed, so that language has to be removed from the local law.

Supervisor Kniffen opened the hearing to public comment. Hearing none, Supervisor Kniffen ordered the hearing closed at PM.
