

APPEARANCE TICKETS

LOCAL LAW NO. 9 OF THE YEAR 1979

A Local Law Authorizing the Issuance of Appearance Tickets By Public Servants of the Town of Kirkwood

Adopted November 7, 1979

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Kirkwood.

Section 1. The purpose of this local law is to authorize public servants of the Town of Kirkwood to issue and serve appearance tickets in connection with violations of state statutes, local laws, ordinances, or rules and regulations of the town which the public servants are authorized or required to enforce.

Section 2. The following public servants of the Town of Kirkwood are hereby authorized to Issue and serve an appearance ticket with respect to violation of a state statute, a local law, ordinance, rule or regulation of the Town of Kirkwood that such public servants are, respectively, required or authorized to enforce:

- a. Building Inspector – Building, zoning, planning matters.
- b. Enforcement Officer – All local laws and ordinances of the Town of Kirkwood.
- c. Dog Control Officer – Article 7 of Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York and Local Law 3-1975 “A Local Law of the Town of Kirkwood Relating to the Control, Confining and Leashing of Dogs.”

Section 3. An appearance ticket other than for a parking violation shall be served personally.

Section 4. The local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
