

**TOWN OF KIRKWOOD
PUBLIC HEARING**

A public hearing to hear public comments regarding a local law entitled “A Local Law Amending the Park Use Local Law Related to the Sale of Alcoholic Beverages” was held on October 1, 2019 at 6:00 at the Joseph A. Griffin Town Hall with Supervisor Gordon Kniffen presiding.

Supervisor Kniffen explained that the sale of beer in our parks is governed by a local law. In the past the Kirkwood Fire Company was given permission to sell beer during the Kirkwood Fair at Veterans River Park, but they chose not to sell it this year. The local law needs to be amended so that beer can still be sold at the Fair, so in the future the Kirkwood Fair Committee will recommend a non-profit Town of Kirkwood organization to sell beer at the Fair and approval will be granted by resolution of the Town Board.

Supervisor Kniffen opened the hearing to public comment. Hearing none, Supervisor Kniffen ordered the hearing closed at 6:05 PM.
